Pubic exam marks are used to determine a score for each eligible student within each of the following categories.

Mathematics:	Mathematics 3201, or 3203, or 3200 or 3208
Science:	Biology 3201, or Chemistry 3202, or Physics 3204, or Earth Systems 3209
Social Studies: (Or French)	Social Studies 3201, or French 3201, or Accelerated French 3203 or Français 3202
2 - Electives:	Two subjects chosen from 1 credit courses in any 3000 level course.

Elective #1	World Religion 3106	1	88	$88 \times 1 = 88$
Elective #2	Phys Ed 3201	1	90	$90 \times 1 = 90$
Average (Sum calculations divided by 10 Credits)				$804 / 10 = \mathbf{80.4}$
